

## Event Report - Department of Bengali



### Seminar

On June 28, 2023, the Department of Bengali organized a class seminar on "Sahitye Manobik Abedan" under the aegis of the college's IQAC. The resource person is Dr. Sanjay Pramanik, an Associate Professor at Vidyasagar Metropolitan College. The way the resource person delivered his message was highly entertaining and enriching for the pupils. The interactive session on the Humanitarian Appeal in Literature was also highly beneficial to both the students and the faculty of the department.



### Webinar on Theatre in post-Pandemic Era
