We have initiated the process of E-governance through the introduction of Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) software from 2019 through a stand-alone mother server connecting all terminals located in the college office through LAN. Generally ERP software enables institutions to manage day to day administrative, academic and financial activities based on a central database by providing insights and internal controls. We use ERP to collect, monitor and utilize student-data for their entire tenure in the institution from the submission of admission application form to the final result of graduation. It manages all related processes of admission, registration, enrolment, submission of fees, application and distribution of scholarships and other financial data management for various schemes of student welfare. From 2021 the we have upgraded the ERP system to AIMS Cloud, a cloud-based framework.

The enhanced online-teaching learning process during the pandemic was continued through G-Suite which we are still using for various purpose. From the session 2022-23 we have introduced ELMS, the cloud-based Learning Management System through which we can provide study materials to the students, take online class-tests and communicate with the students as when needed.

The college regularly procures updated computers and related accessories for the smooth functioning of academic and administrative activities in the college which is evident from a large number of desktops and laptops available in the college. These devices are connected with high-speed internet through a campus-wide Wi-Fi network maintained by Speed-net Broadband and BSNL Broadband Connections with a speed of 350Mbps (gross). Most of these devices also run on the latest Original Genuine Operating Systems and are equipped with anti-virus software for data protection.

The central library too is benefitting from such updated IT facilities as it records books into the KOHA software, and provide remote access to teachers and students of the records through Online Open Access Catalogue (OPAC).

There is also a dedicated portal for exclusive online management of the admission process. Till 2023-24 academic session the entire admission process had been conducted by the college admission implementation committee through online portal. From 2024-25 academic session this process has been implemented by the centralised admission portal of state government.

All financial transactions, including salary, grants etc. are also managed digitally through IFMS and PFMS systems. Transaction of RUSA 2.0 account, related to the construction of building and procurements has been processed through PFMS.
